Tim Regan Dead

The news of the death of Tim Regan (26) one of the cleverest and most daring Irish steeplechase jockeys, will come as a great shock to his many friends and to a host of racegoers with whom he was extremely popular. Regan was taken ill after riding Ballygreen at Tramore and was conveyed to hospital. He was found to be suffering from pneumonia, and hopes were entertained for his recovery. He was a native of Ballinabinech, county Limerick.

His death while in his prime makes his loss all the more deeply to be regretted. Regan was attached to the Youghal stable so successfully managed by Matt Cunningham, for whom he rode many winners. He won the Galway Plate on Seaview and the Galway Hurdle on Kate Carlin.

He was equally successful over a natural country such as Pucchestown, where among many winners he rode That's Him. He rode many winners in England.

Regan's father, Tim Regan, was one of the leading jockeys of his day, and Mick, Jack and Stephen are other members of the family.
