

Student Drowned

Bathing Tragedy In Co. Limerick

A sad drowning tragedy occurred at Dromore Lake, Pallaskenty, on Thursday afternoon, when Richard Kelly, a student at Copswood College, was drowned while bathing with some companions.

He had been but a short time in the water when he got into difficulties. A fellow student promptly went to his rescue but before he could reach him he had disappeared.

Shortly after the body was recovered by one of the assistants attached to the college, who was with the bathing party.

Kelly was a native of Cahir, county Tipperary, and a distressing feature of the tragedy was that he had been postulante for the priesthood and was due to have left for England in a few weeks.
