

Died After Bathing

Limerickman's Sad Death

While leaving the water after a bath at Kilkee on Sunday afternoon Benjamin O'Leary, aged 44, of Limerick, got a seizure and collapsed in about four inches of water. He was dragged from the water to the strand by some children. Guard Cosroy, who was on the scene, applied artificial respiration for two hours, but it was of no avail. Spiritual aid was rendered by Rev. Father Clancy, C. C., Kilkee.

The deceased was employed as a buyer at Messrs Todd and Co, Limerick, and he leaves a wife and four children.

Death is believed to be due to heart failure.
