Death of Ex-Senator Barrington

Passing of Famous Limerick Engineer.

The death took place on Thursday night at his residence, (Belgrave rquare, Monkstown, Co. Dublin, of ex Senator William Barrington in his 80th year. He was born in Limerick, son of Mr John Barrington, solr, Limerick, and took up engineering, being largely identified with tidal reclamation, arterial derinage and with railway development. The was responsible for the construction of many of the light railways built in this country. He was managing director of the Fergus reclamation, one of the bigg wi tidal reclamation schemes exsouted in this country in recent years. He was elected to the Free State Senate in 1927, but was defeated at the trienoial election of 1331. As a Senator he took a keen interest in schemes of hydro-sleerriftcation and drain ge. Amongst other mair totions he was a member of the Limerick Co. Club.
