

Late Mr J Buckley, B.L.

Mr Jeremiah Buckley, B.L. A.O.A., of 11 Park Avenue, Sandymount, of Messrs Keane and Co, chartered accountants, died in a Dublin private hospital.

Mr Buckley, who was proprietor of the "Limerick Leader," was born in Cork. He was imprisoned in Parnell's days and played an active part in the National movement.

The removal of the remains took place on Thursday evening to St Andrew's Church, Westland Row.

The chief mourners were:—Mrs Buckley (widow); Mr John Buckley and Mr Neil Buckley (sons), and Miss Eileen Buckley (daughter).

Mr Maurice O'Donnell, M.L., was also present.

The body was received at the church by Rev P Carton, C.C.

The funeral, which was private, took place to day to Glasnevin Cemetery.
