

Limerick Airman Killed

FUNERAL IN CITY

The remains of First-Class Aircraftman Michael Kirwan, one of the three airmen of the British Royal Air Force killed on Friday when a giant bomber crashed into the sea off the West coast, arrived in Limerick. Deceased, who was born in Limerick 23 years ago, was son of Mr James Kirwan, Customs and Excise, Liverpool, formerly of Limerick, and nephew of Mr P. McMahon, 31 High Street, Limerick. The interment took place to day in Mount St Lawrence Cemetery, after Solemn High Mass in St Michael's Church. Three wreaths were sent from the sergeant and men of the section to which deceased belonged.
