Labourer Killed

At New Coment Pactory

As a result of an extraordinary accident at the new coment fuctory being ere ted at Mungret one man was killed and another rather seriously injured of Thursday afternoon. The dead man is Thomas O'Bourke, aged about 30, of Kildimo, and the injured man Patrick Mulcahy, of Counigar.

The accident occurred when three men were standing on a pile about fifteen feet from the ground. They were using a large jick for the purpose of revolving a piece of machinery that was being lustalled. The jick snapped suddenly and portion of it caught the unfortunate man O'Rourke on the object and face. He was pitched off the pile and killed almost instantly, Mulahy was also thrown from the pile and snatsined injuries to the arm and legs the is progressing favourably in the Limerick County Infirmary. The third min, John Bridgeman jumped clear just in time.

Rev Father O'Connor, 8.J., ministered to O'Rourke and Mulcahy, and the deceased was later removed to the County Infirmary.
