

Death of Mr Batt. Skehan.

It is, with feelings of the most sincere regret that we record the death of Mr Bartholomew Skehan, of Bridgetown, Co. Clare, which sad event took place after an operation at Barrington's Hospital, on Wednesday night.

The late Mr Skehan was Chairman of the Bridgetown Co Operative Creamery since its establishment in 1903, and was a Peace Commissioner for a number of years.

He unsuccessfully contested the General Election in 1922. Prior to the Union Amalgamation Scheme, the deceased gentleman was for a number of years a member of the Limerick Board of Guardians, Chairman of the Limerick No. 3 District Council and a member of the Clare County Council.

Quite and unassuming, the late Mr Skehan was a man of the highest probity in all his dealings.

The remains were removed on Thursday evening to Bridgetown Church, and the interment, which took place in the adjoining cemetery to day (Friday) after Requiem Mass was truly a striking manifestation of sympathy and respect.
