Deceased was on his way to the Parochial House, and when outside the residence of Mr John Lynch, at Summerhill, he was seen to collepse. He was carried into Mr Lynch's house, and Hev M O'Rahilly, co, and Dr Courtney were quickly on the scene. Father O'Rahilly administered the last rites of the Church.

The sad news spread rapidly, and a large crowdcollected outside the house and recited the Rosary. All amusements in the town

were at once suspended.

Exritor in the day Father Murray had assisted at High Mass in the Church of St Mary's of the Rosary, in connection wish the Feast of Christ the King, and also an hour before his death at Solemn Benediction.

The deceased priest was 47 years of age, and a native Miltown Malory, Co. Clare. After some years in the English Mission be was recalled to the Diocess of Killalos, and ministered at Newmarket-on-Fergus, Cioniara, where he was a most popular figure, and for the past nine years in Menage.
