

Death of Mr. William Duggan, N.T.

It is with most sincere regret that we announce the death of Mr William Duggan, N.T., which sad event took place at his residence, O'Brien's Bridge, Co. Clare, on Monday, and sincere sympathy will be extended to his widow, Mrs Nora Duggan, N.T., and family, in her bereavement. An old citizen of Limerick, the late Mr Duggan was Principal of St. Patrick's National Schools, Limerick, prior to his retirement on full pension some few years ago. A fine sportsman, and an able exponent of the Rugby code, the late Mr "Billy" Duggan will be remembered as having figured as a threequarter for a number of seasons with Garryowen F.C., and his name is inscribed on victorious sides in the historic Munster Cup. The remains will be removed to Bridgetown Church this (Tuesday) evening at 8 o'clock, and the interment will take place to morrow after Requiem Mass.
