Limerickman Passes Away in Dublin

The death took place in Dublin of Mr James Hayes, 14 St Michael's Road, Glasnevin, Dublin. Deceased, who was a native of Limerick, was brother of Mr Tom Hayes, the well-known Limerick Co. All Ireland hurler of some years ago, and was employed for 40 years in the Central Telegraph Office, during the last fifteen years of which he held the responsible position of overseer. The remains were removed, after Requiem Mass, from St Francis Xavier's Church, Dublin, and conveyed to Limerick. Here they were met by a huge concourse, which made the funeral journey to Mungret where the interment took place. Amongst the chief mourners were—Thomas Hayes (brother), T Hayes (nephew), Misses E and N Hayes (nieces), and M Hayes (cousin).
