

# Patriotic Clare Family Bereaved

## Death of Mrs Considine

A popular and respected Ennis family has met with a double bereavement which has occasioned feelings of deepest sympathy in Clare. A few days ago Mr Sylvester Considine died and was interred at Dromcliffe, Ennis. On Saturday morning the death of his mother, Mrs Mary E Considine, Vale Cottage, Ennis, took place after a short illness. Deceased was the mother of seven sons, five of whom survive her, and four daughters. Her sons included Mr Brendan Considine, manager of the Munster and Leinster Bank, Carrickmacross; Mr Turlough Considine, manager, Ennis Labour Exchange; Mr D Considine, Stationmaster, Athboy, county Meath; Mr Joseph Considine, Civil Service, Dublin; and Mr Wm Considine, Inspector, Board of Works. She was also the mother-in-law of Mr Sean O'Grady, T.D., Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Lands. The family was intimately connected with the National struggle and prominently associated with the Old I.R.A. and later the Young I.R.A.
