

Tragedy At Golf Links

Well-Known Citizen Collapses

Sudden Death of Mr Aylmer Cleeve

A profound shock was felt in the city late on Monday evening when it became known that Mr Aylmer Cleeve, a member of the well-known Limerick family of that name, had died suddenly at the Limerick Golf Links, Ballyclough, Roxboro'.

The late Mr Cleeve, it appears, had gone to the Links some time previously, and shortly before 9 p.m. had a sudden seizure. He was attended by Dr Corboy, and, despite medical skill, passed away.

The late Mr Cleeve, who was an extremely popular citizen, was quite a young man, being only 45 years of age. He resided at Shelbourne House, N.U.R., to where the Corporation ambulance removed the body.
