Inquest in Limerick

An elderly woman, Miss W Armstrong, 13 Rutland street, Limerick, died on Saturday evening at Barrington's Hospital as the result of injuries received when she was knocked down by a motor car near her home on the 28th July.

The Inquest

An inquest was opened on the circumstances touching the deceased's death at Barrington's Hospital this afternoon by Mr J S McNeice, Deputy City Coroner.

Evidence of identification was given by a sister of the deceased, with whom she resided.

Dr McDonagh, House Surgeon, Barrington's Hospital, gave evidence of de ceased's admission to the Institution, suffering from fractures of the arms and legs, as well as internal injuries.
