Death of Mr D. P. Quane

The death which occurred recently of Mr D P Quane, Rathanny, Hospital, has occasioned widespread sympathy. Deceased was only about 23 years of age, and his genial disposition appealed to every one he was acquainted with. Son of Mrs D Quane, Rathanny, he was a member of an old county Limerick family, and his death at such an early age is keenly felt in the district. His remains were removed to Knockaney parish church, where the Mass was recited for the repose of his soul by a large number of relatives, friends and sympathisers. The interment took place in the adjoining cemetery after Office and Requiem Mass, and there was a vast gathering of people at the grave.
