

Death Of Lord Daresbury

Lord Daresbury (formerly Sir-Gilbert Greenall) died in London on Sunday. He was 71.

The family seats are Walton Hall, Warrington, and Mount Coote, Kilmallock, co. Limerick.

About 1802 Lord Daresbury acquired a residence and demesne at Mount Coote, to which he subsequently made substantial additions and effected many improvements. He was keenly interested in raising cattle and kept an extensive dairy. He was a liberal supporter of Kilmallock Agricultural and Industrial Show, and also Ardpatrick and Kilfinane coursing meetings.
