

Limerick Auditor Dies in Dublin

Mr James Dore, whose death took place at his residence, 2 Emmett Road, Inchicore, at the age of 40, was a member of a well-known West Limerick family.

By profession an auditor, he was attached to the firm of Messrs Donal O'Connor and Co, chartered accountants, Westmoreland street, Dublin.

He was a native of Gartnagloeb, Templeglantine, and had been a member of the G.A.A. and Old L.R.A. There was a large attendance at the removal of the remains from his residence to St Michael's Church, Inchicore.

After Requiem Mass the funeral left by road for Monaghan, county Limerick, where the interment took place.
