

Distressing Fatality

Woman Cyclist Killed in Limerick

Child Seriously Injured

A very distressing fatality took place in the city last night by which a married woman named Mrs Nora Coffey, Ballyclough, Ballysimon, aged 38 years, lost her life, and her child, aged 5 years, was badly injured.

It appears that the woman was cycling in Upper Clare street in the vicinity of St. Patrick's Church, with her child riding pillion, when she came into collision with a motor car stated to be driven by Dr. McPolio, County and City Medical Officer of Health, receiving serious injuries to the head and a fractured leg, which proved fatal.

The little child was picked up seriously injured and conveyed to hospital by a passing motorist.
