

Limerick-Born Prelate Dies

Right Rev Monsignor M F McAuliffe, Vicar General of the Maitland Diocese, Australia, died in hospital at Waratah a few weeks after returning from a health trip to Ireland. He was in his 70th year.

A native of county Limerick, he studied at St Munchin's College, Limerick, and St Patrick's College, Carlow, and graduated B.A. and R.U.I. Ordained in 1894, he arrived in the Maitland diocese the same year.

His brothers are Rev E McAuliffe, P.P. [Kensington, Archdiocese of Sydney]; and Mr James McAuliffe, county Limerick. His sisters are Mrs L O'Shea, county Limerick, and Sister M Malachy [Sisters of Mercy, St Louis, U.S.A.]
