

not been as heretofore, the old order changeth and applies not only to the suppliers of milk but to every branch of enterprise. Happy-go-lucky, methods are being discarded with a vengeance and what was looked upon as a virtue a decade ago is now an effence. People saw nothing very wrong at one time in the milk supply being hawked from door to door in an open container by a slovenly woman whose hands may not have seen soap and water for the better part of a week. She commits an offence now should the attempt anything of the kind. Everything calculated to contaminate this nutritious article of diet is punishable. No longer will it suffice to say in a case of dilution that the milk was sent to market as it came from the cow, or if carried in a dirty cart that the rat was no alternative. At the City District Court yestesday a number of suppliers were fined not heavily for the latter. offence. It should be unnecessary to prosecute at all if the defendants had the remotest conception of cleanliness and the danger arising from contamination. Next time people are prosecuted for marketing under such unhygenic conditions the maximum penalty may be imposed.
