EXILE'S DEATH.

County Limerick Man Passes Away in U.S.A.

The death has taken place at his summer residence, Eagle River, Wisconsin, of Mr. Patrick O'Malley, a native of Moher, Ballyagran, Co. Limerick. Deceased, who was a very prominent figure in the business and political life of Chicago, visited his home in Ireland at frequent intervals, the last occasion being about six years ago. He possessed a very charming personality, and despite his fifty years' residence in the States maintained to the end his great affection for all the friends and acquaintances of his boyhood days. The interment took place at Cavalry Cemetery, after Solemn Requiem High Mass at St. John's Church, Chicago.

On the occasion of one of his recent visits to Ireland, Mr. O'Malley built an imposing residence on the site of the old homestead, fitted throughout with electric light and modern equipment of every sort. The news of his death has been received with widespread regret
