## Volley Fired Over Grave

Military honours were accorded at the funeral after Requiem Mass on Thursday, of Mr James Herbert, Inchamore, Ballina, Co. Tipperary, brother of Sister Peter, Mercy Convent, Barr, and of Sister Albert, Mercy Convent, Tullis. He was aged 50 years. A pioneer of the Sinn Féin movement, and later of the Volunteer movement, he served with the I.R.A. during the Anglo-Irish war and the civil war. His comrades of the O.A.I.R.A., in charge of Seán Carroll, Carrigrohane, fired a volley over the grave. Rev. Fr. O'Shea, C.C., Ballina, and Rev. Fr. Crowe, C.C., Kilsloe, conducted the burial service. A number of wreaths, including one from his old comrades of the Ballina Coy., were placed on the Tricolour-draped coffin.
