

Limerick Compositor Dead

An old and esteemed member of the Limerick Typographical Society has passed away in the person of Mr Michael O'Rielly. Though not enjoying the best of health for a considerable time, his death, which took place at his residence, 14 Lord Edward st., on Tuesday, was not expected by his colleagues in the printing profession.

Deceased, who was a staunch trades unionist, an ardent Irishman, and a sincere and loyal friend, will be sadly missed by his relatives, but by none more than his fellow members, who will ever entertain the happiest memories of a gentleman in conduct and manner.
