

Wife's Terrible Experience

Sees Her Husband Killed

Mrs Sarah Kennedy described at an inquest at Nenagh how she saw her husband, Patrick Kennedy, cottage rent collector to Nenagh Urban Council, killed outright by a milk van while both of them were cycling. The inquest was adjourned.

Mrs Kennedy said her husband and she were cycling to work when the van struck her husband.

The coroner (Dr Courtney) said deceased and his brother, who was killed in action during the Anglo-Irish war, were great Irishmen, and this tragic death, even in these days when life seemed to be getting very cheap on the roads, was a great shock.

Deceased was one of the firing party at the funeral of Capt G O'Leary, Nenagh, on Thursday.
