

# City Man's Death

## Inquest Verdict

The death took place at Barrington's Hospital on Saturday of Thomas Hanly (65), Rosemary Place, Limerick. Deceased man was injured while working in the City Roller Mills on Monday morning. It is understood he was cleaning some portion of the engine when the accident occurred.

A verdict that deceased died from bronchial pneumonia and cardiac failure, following injuries received in the course of his employment, was returned at the inquest held to-day by Deputy Coroner J S McNeice, solr.

Sympathy was tendered to the relatives by the coroner and jury and the Supt Garda Siochana.
