Cyclist's Death

Sudden braking caused the death of Michael MacNamara (about 50) herdsman, as he was cycling towards his home on Saturday night, according to Sergt Long's evidence at the inquest at Clare County Hospital.

MacNamara braked at the foot of a hill and was thrown.

He was employed by the Irish Land Commission at Castlefergus, Quin.

Death was accidental, the jury found.
