

Death of Dr F W Kennedy

Distinguished Limerickman

The death occurred in a London nursing home recently of Dr F W Kennedy, aged 76 years. The late Dr Kennedy was a distinguished member of the medical profession in Limerick up to his retirement in 1933. He was educated in Trinity College, Dublin, and, on obtaining his degree, rapidly built up an extensive practice in his native city and in Clare. In his young days he was an accomplished cricketer and a member of the Limerick County Tennis Club. He played for Munster and the Gentlemen of Ireland in cricket. Dr Kennedy is survived by his widow, a daughter of the late Mr R O'Brien Studdert, Cuibane Castle, Kilkishen, county Clare, and two sons.
