

N.T.'s Death

Limerick Senator Bereaved

Mr David D Madden, former N.T, whose death has taken place, was one of three brothers who were long and successfully connected with the teaching profession in West Limerick. His brother, John, was principal in Dromcollogher N.S, and his other brother, Patrick, was late principal in Foynes. Deceased began his career in Feenagh as monitor with his father-in-law, known throughout the province as the "Great Dan Sullivan." He was appointed principal in Feenagh about 1878, and retired in Monmouth in 1919. The funeral from Fedamore Church to Kilmeedy was largely attended.
