

Death of Mr C M Going

The death has taken place of Mr Charles M Going, of Cragg, Birdhill, co. Tipperary. The deceased had been a member of the old Grand Jury of North Tipperary and a Justice of the Peace. He was an extensive landowner, a successful breeder and exhibitor of livestock, and a fairminded and reasonable business man in his capacity as agent to several local estates. Deceased was an ex-Master of the Lerry-Castle hounds and was recognized as one of the best judges of foxhounds in Britain and Ireland. Right Rev Dr Harvey, Bishop of Cashel, and a number of clergymen, officiated at the funeral.
