

Death of Mr W G Peacocke

The death took place at his residence, Southville, Limerick, on Thursday, of Mr Wm George Peacocke, after an illness of some duration. The deceased was a member of an old Limerick family prominently identified with the public life of the city. He received his education at the Crescent College, Limerick, and was for some years on the commercial staff of the "Irish Independent" when it was controlled by the Parnellite Party. He later returned to Limerick to take over the extensive oil and colour business owned by his family. He was a member of the Limerick Corporation in 1905 and succeeding years and was a Justice of the Peace and City Grand Juror. Deceased was a tireless worker on behalf of the Limerick Horse Show since its revival, and was most assiduous in the many duties that fell to his lot during the annual fixture. Mr Peacocke was in every sense of the word a good citizen and firm friend, and his loss is deeply regretted. Deceased was a brother of Mr J Peacocke, B.E., former city surveyor, now retired.
