## Death of Mr W G Peacocke

The death took place at his residence, Southville, Limerick, on Thursday, of Mr. Wm George Peacooke, after an illness of some duration. The deceased was a mem ber of an old Limerick family prominently identified with the public life of the city. He received his education at the Crescent College, Limerick, and was for some years on the commercial staff of the "[rish In dependent" when it was controlled by the Parnellite Party. He later returned to Limerick to take over the extensive oil and colour business owned by his family. He was a member of the Limerick Corporation in 1905 and succeeding years and was a Justice of the Peace and City Grand Juror Decreased was a tite ess worker on behalf of the Limerick Horse Show since its revival, and was most assidious in the many duties that fell to his lot during the annual fix ure. Mr Peacocke was in every sence of the word a good citizen and firm friend, and his loss is deeply ragretted. Deceased was a brother of Mr J Peacocke, BE, former city surveyor, now retired.
