

Sad Drowning Fatality

How Little Boy Lost His Life

A boy named Denis Earls, aged 9, who lived at 73 Mungret street, Limerick, was drowned in the Mulkear river at Castletroy, near Limerick, on Sunday night.

It would appear that the lad while crossing the river by means of the city water supply pipe-line which spans the Mulkear, toppled in and was drowned. His brother Christopher, aged 12, and other boys who were with the deceased, raised the alarm. The body was later recovered in about 12 feet of water.

At an inquest held at Castletroy on Monday by Dr P J Clery, coroner for East Limerick, a verdict of accidental drowning was returned.
