

Cappamore Man's Death In U.S.A.

Mr John Mulcahy, who died at his residence, Park Avenue, Bronx, New York, was a native of Cappamore, county Limerick, and in his early manhood went to New York, where he soon became active in Irish organisations. He was a former president of the Municipal Council of the Friends of Irish Freedom, and was also a member, amongst other organisations, of the American Irish Historical Society. He was a well-known breeder of Irish terriers and Kerry blues. His widow, Mrs Marie McSweeney Mulcahy, is a native of county Kerry. A sister is Mrs J English, Lattin, county Tipperary.
