Dies in Dublin

Very Rev James Canon Breen, parish priest of Booterstown, County Dublin, since 1937, died at his residence on Sunday.

Canon Breen, who was a native of Limerick, was first appointed curate at Lusk, Co. Dublin. After 12 years he was transferred to Dundrum, where he ministered for six years until he was changed to Saint Laurence O'Toole's, Seville Place, Dublin. In 1919 he became P.P. of Kilbride, Co. Wicklow, and a year after he was transferred to Arklow. Then in 1924 he was made Canon by the Metropolitan Chapter.

The late Canon Breen was held in affection by the people of every parish in which he ministered.
