

City Sudden Death

Labourer's Collapse at Sarsfield Barracks

Shortly after arriving for work at Sarsfield Barracks, Limerick, on Saturday morning, where he had been engaged on road repairs, Wm Byrne, labourer, aged about 44 years, of 39 Roxtown Terrace, complained of weakness. Workmen went to his assistance and had him conveyed to the first aid station in the barracks, where he was attended by the military doctor. He died in about twenty minutes. An inquest was not considered necessary as death was attributed to heart failure. Deceased was an unmarried man.
