Limerick County Council Adjourns

The Limerick County Council at its meeting on Saturday adjourned without transacting any business as a mark of respect to the late Mr C'ora O'Sullivan, Newcastle West, a former member.

The Chairman (Mr J McCormack) said it was with very real regret he had to propose a vote of sympathy with the family of Mr O'Sullivan. The deceased during his lifetime had proved himself a sterling Irishman and a great worker for the people. He was prominently identified with several agricultural bodies—the Irish Dairy Short-horn Breeders' Society and the Limerick Farmers' Union.

Senator Madden said that the very least tribute the council could pay was to adjourn.

Mr M O'Donnell, in proposing the motion of adjournment, paid a glowing tribute to the many fine qualities of the deceased and said in private life he was a most kindly and charitable man.
