that in large number of cases there were only eleven Court prosecutions. It is always the policy of the Society, if at all possible, to avoid having to bring delinquent parents before the Court; rather does it seek the betterment of the children by firmly impressing on neglectful parents their duty to fair play with their children, and by frequent and unexpected supervisory visits to the home. As the report shows, the vast majority of parents respond to such tactful and humane methods, and only for a very small number has the majesty of the law to be invoked.

The balance sheet shows that the revenue of the Limerick and Clare Branch is less than the annual expenses and that the deficit has to be made good from contributions from more prosperous Branches. This is an unsatisfactory state of affairs. The Limerick Branch should be self-supporting and we trust that the fillip which it will get from the general meeting will bring about that desirable change.
