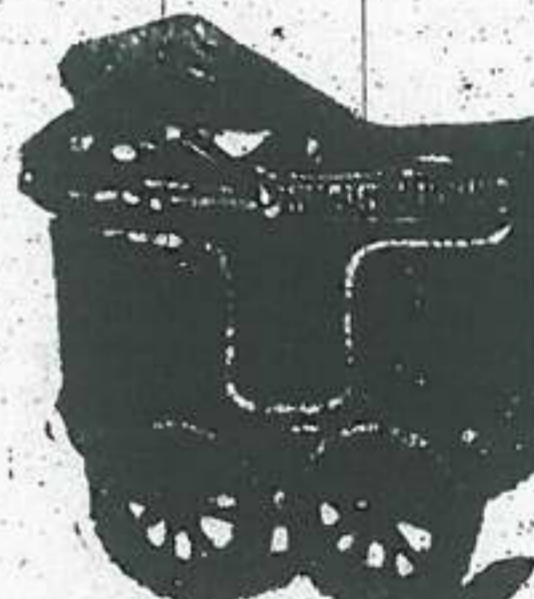
## PROSECUTION UNDER FORESTRY ACT
