Death by suicide, during a fit of temporary insanity, was the verdint at an inquest in Liscannor touching the circumstances connected with the death of Denis

Vaughan, of Carrowduff, Liscannor.

The evidence went to show that deceased left his home on 25th December after partaking of his Christmas dinner. He took with him his shotgun, believed for the purpose of shooting crows. He was last seen alive by Mrs Reidy, whose house he visited, and after reading a newspaper left again. When he did not turn up a search party went out and he was found on his own land, close to his house, dead, with several wounds in the stomack. The gun was close by.

Deceased was an extensive farmer, married, with four children. He was highly popular, and the sympathy of the entire district goes out to his wife and family in their sad beconvenent under such tragie
