Funeral of Captain J. Landon at Watford

James Landon, of Killeely, co Limerick, was interred at the Cathedral Cemetery, Watford, on Saturday morning after Requiem Mass in Holyrood Church, where the body lay overnight. The clergy officiating were Canon Jackman, Fathers Oddie, Ellis and Frost.

Father Ellis, assisted by Father Frost, officiated at the graveside. Both priests are Irishmen and personal friends of the Landon family. Father Frost is a native of Clealara, county Clare.
