

Countess of Dunraven Dead

The Countess of Dunraven and Mount Earl died at Adare Manor, county Limerick, aged 81. Daughter of the Sixth Earl of Mayo, she married in 1885 the Earl of Dunraven, who succeeded his cousin in 1926, and has two sons and a daughter living, the eldest son being Viscount Adare.

The Funeral

The village of Adare was in mourning when the remains were laid to rest in the family vault attached to Adare church.

Shops were shut and blinds drawn when the coffin, borne on a simple farm cart and covered with wreaths, emerged from the main gate of Adare Manor. On either side walked workers on the estate. On arrival at the church a brief service was held by the Rt Rev Dr Irwin, Bishop of Limerick, assisted by Rev S Dault, Rector, Adare, and Rev A E Hewston-Jones, Limerick.

The chief mourners were:—Viscount Adare and the Hon. Valentine Maurice Wynnham Quinn (son), Lady Olien Wyndham Quinn (daughter); Viscountess Adare, the Knight of Glin and Madam Fitzgerald.
