Barge Man Loses His Life

Sad Occurrence at O'Dwyer Bridge

A saddrowning tragedy occurred at the new jetty, near O'Dwyer Bridge, Athlun kard street, at about 2 45 am this morning, when a middle aged man named Thomas Crowe, a native of Killaloe, lost his life. It appears that Crowe was boarding a boat the property of Mesars Ranks, on which he was employed, when he slipped and fell into about 7 or 8 feet of water. Several attempts were made to rescue him, but without success. Some time later the body was recovered and removed to the morgue at Barrington's Hospital. Deceased's son resided on the barge with him.

Guard Murr by, Mary street, who witnessed the occurrence, made commendable but unsuccessful attempts at rescue.
