

The Late Mr. J. A. Bourke

The announcement of the death, which occurred on Thursday morning at his residence, "Auburn," Eoinn Road, of Mr Joseph A Bourke, was received with most genuine feelings of regret in his native Limerick.

Deceased, who had been ailing for some time, had reached a fairly ripe age. He was for a long number of years Manager of Messrs Martin McGuire & Sons, flour millers and corn merchants, Francis street, Limerick, where he ever held the complete confidence of his employers.
