Death of Mr. Patrick O'Kelly

We regret sincerely to announce the death, which occurred at the County Infirmary, Limerick, on Sunday last of Mr Patrick O'Kelly, after a rather protracted illness.

Deceased who was a well-known and very popular figure in Limerick city for many years, had been employed at Messrs Wm. Todd & Co's furniture department practically since boyhood. A native of Newcastle West, the deceased who was a man of splendid physique, was ever prominent in the athletic and social life of the city for over 40 years, his proverbial good humour and genial disposition making for him hosts of friends.

A strong trades unionist, the late Mr O'Kelly was an active member of the Limerick Branch of the Irish Union of Distributive Workers and Clerks, occupying the Presidency of the branch for some years.

The remains were removed from the Infirmary to Newcastle West on Monday evening, and reposed there in the Church overnight. The funeral took place to Churchtown Cemetery to day (Tuesday).
