

Limerick Youth Killed

Fatal Accident In Ennis Station

Gerald Reid (17½) a native of Limerick, employed as an engine cleaner at the Ennis Railway Station, died in the Clare county Infirmary on Wednesday as the result of fatal injuries received when he fell and was jammed between the platform and carriage of a slowly moving train.

An inquest conducted by Dr J H Connihan coroner, a verdict of accidental death was returned without blame being attached to anybody.
