

Sad Death

West Limerickman's Fate

Coroner Cussen, Newcastle West, held an inquest into the circumstances of the death of a labourer named John O'Connor, of Kilacullen, near Abbeyfeale, on Friday evening, in the cottage of the deceased.

Supt J Kelly represented the State.

From the evidence it appeared that a colt in training had been placed under a car for the second time and bolted off the road at Glenmore. The deceased, who was with two others at the time, sustained injuries to his back and head, which caused his death.

Dr P McCarthy, Abbeyfeale, said death resulted from shock following injuries to the head and lumbar region.

The jury found accordingly and voted sympathy with the family of deceased.
