

Shocking County Tragedy

Two Year Old Child's Death

A child, Wim Curtin, aged two years, was drowned in the river near Kilmallock on Saturday. He was last seen on the river bank by children playing in the vicinity. His absence was reported to the guards, a search was made, and the body found some distance further on in about six feet of water.

On the recovery of the body Guard McNamara applied artificial respiration.

An inquest was held by Doctor John Clery, coroner.

Dr M J O'Connor gave evidence to the effect that death was due to asphyxia, the result of drowning, and a verdict was recorded accordingly.

Sympathy was expressed with the parents.
