Dr Philip McCarthy, who made a post mortem, stated that on the 30th April he

examined the body of a female infant; it was probably dead 6 or 7 weeks; it was of full term birth, and died from asphyxiation and inattention at b rth.

Sergeant Lysaght stated he found the infant in the old sacking lying face downwards. The head was wrapped up in a piece of a shirt and some other piece of cloth. He also found about it an old newspaper, a piece of soap box, and a match box.

The jury, of whom Mr David Broderick

was foreman, found in accordance with Dr McCarthy's evidence. There was no evidence to connect anyone with the matter.
