

Fatally Injured

County Limerick Tragedy

Mr Wm Crowley, Ballynaveen, Emly, county Tipperary, was fatally injured on Saturday morning when his bicycle came into collision with a motor car. Crowley's head and face was so severely injured as to cause his death within a few minutes of the impact. Deceased was a prominent member of the Emly hurling and football teams, and was son of Mr and Mrs Timothy Crowley.

The remains were removed to Emly church and the interment took place in the presence of a large and representative congregation. The coffin was borne from the church to the cemetery by members of the Emly G.A.A., while other members formed a guard of honour.

The inquest on the body was opened on Saturday evening and adjourned after medical evidence and evidence of identification had been received.
