Motor Driver Exonerated

A verdict of death from shock a haemorrhage following injuries was returned at the resumed inquest at Askeaton, Co. Limerick, on Michael O'Connell, a building contractor, of Newtown, Pallaskeenry, who was killed when the motor bicycle he was riding was in collision with a motor car at Askeaton on May 20 last.

The Deputy Coroner, Mr M Cussen, said that the State had decided not to go any further with the criminal proceedings. The driver of the car, Patrick J Moran, was exonerated from blame.
